CHESS GROUND RULES

I. TOURNAMENT RULES

The tournament shall be governed by FIDE Laws of Chess (January 2023) and those stated in the following ground rules.

- A. Chess shall be played as a team and individual competition in standard game
 - a. One (1) team for the boys and one (1) team for the girls in Elementary level.
 - b. One (1) team for the boys and one (1) team for the girls in Secondary level.
 - c. Each team shall be composed of two (2) players and a coach.
- B. Chess clock and Chess Set:
 - a. Use of digital chess clock, and chess mat is compulsory
- C. There shall be separate championships for the boys and the girls.
 - a. Team Standard:
 - Elementary — Boys and Girls
 - Secondary — Boys and Girls
 - *Team championship —Total scores of 2 players
 - * A team with one player can play for individual event only and shall not qualify in the team event.
 - b. Individual Standard:
 - *Individual championship —The standing of the player after the end of the competition and tie-breaks
- D. Players shall be **required to present their ID's** before the start of each round. Use of uniforms shall be mandatory on the 1st and last round.
- E. Players, coaches and spectators are not allowed to make post game analysis, play against each other coaches, spectators and players or discuss finished or unfinished games within the playing area.
- F. Players are not allowed to eat inside the playing area while the game is in progress.
- G. Players who have finished their games shall arrange the chess pieces and vacate the playing area after signing their score sheets and submit it to the designated tournament officials.

- H. Players must observe proper dress code while playing. The following are prohibited:
- a. Use of slippers
 - b. Using short pants/sandos
- I. Players are prohibited to bring gadgets or wearable devices inside the playing venue such as but not limited to the following:
- a. cellphones/smart phones
 - b. earbuds/headphone
 - c. smart watches
 - d. other electronic devices

II. RULES AND REGULATIONS

A. STANDARD CHESS

- a. Time control shall be one (1) hour and 5 minutes to finish the game using the digital clock.
- b. Recording of moves in algebraic notation is mandatory throughout the game. Violation of this rules shall be considered as an offense.
- c. Illegal moves:
 - ✓ wrong movement of piece
 - ✓ exposing the King to an attack
 - ✓ King remaining under check
 - ✓ capturing the opponent's King
 - ✓ using two hands in making a move
 - ✓ non-replacement of piece after pawn promotion and
 - ✓ pressing the clock without making a move

Penalty:

- 1st offense — plus 2 minutes to the opponent's time
2nd offense — forfeiture of the game

- d. Infringement: Infringements made by the player such as:
 - ✓ displacement of pieces on the chess board;
 - ✓ use of force in pressing the clock
 - ✓ non recording of moves shall be penalized as follows:

- 1st and 2nd offense — oral warning
3rd offense - plus 2 minutes to the opponent's time
4th offense — forfeiture of the game

- e. The defaulting time is 15 minutes after the official start of each round.

B. GAME POINTS SCORING SYSTEM

A player is credited 1 point for a win, 0.5 for a draw, and 0 for a loss

C. TIE-BREAKS

INDIVIDUAL RESULTS

The following tie-break system (in descending order of priority) shall be applied to determine the final ranking:

1. Direct Encounter
2. Sonneborn-Berger System
3. Rapid Game (20mins). No recording.
4. Reduced time of Rapid Game by 5 minutes shall be played to resolve the tie. No recording.

TEAM RESULTS

- i. Combined S.B. Tie Breaks of the members of the Team
- ii. Combined Greater Number of Victories of the members of the Team
- iii. Score of the player with the highest number of points.

III. Top player of the Team

The coach shall designate the top player as board-1 and the next player as board-2.

IV. Top Individual Player

The top individual player for each category shall be the champion of board 1 players.

V. SELECTION OF COACHES

The coach of the player who secures the highest individual ranking in the tournament for each category will be selected to advance to the next level of competition.

B. The decision of the Chief Arbiter on a Point of Law is Final.

Protests:

1. Protest on technicalities shall be put in writing, signed by the coach and the head of the regional delegation. It should be submitted to the Tournament Director (TD) within 30 minutes immediately after the conclusion of the match in protest. The TD shall decide within 30 minutes upon receipt of the protest.
2. All protests must be supported with the necessary evidence and attachments. Video recordings taken privately will not be considered as evidence.
3. The decision of the TD shall be appealable. Only questions on laws are appealable to the Jury of Appeal. Appeals shall be put in writing, signed by the head of delegation and shall be submitted to the Jury within 30 minutes upon receipt of the decision.
4. The Jury of Appeal shall decide within 30 minutes upon receipt of the written appeal. The decision made by the Jury is final, irrevocable, and executory.

VI. IRREGULARITIES AND PENALTIES

- A. Mobile phones and other means of electronic communications are strictly prohibited inside the playing area. A player who will violate this rule shall lose his/her game.
- B. A team whose member is giving unsolicited advice or assistance to his teammate while the games are in progress shall lose their match.
- C. A player who will bring the game into **disrepute** shall be penalized expulsion from the competition.

VII. COLATILLA

All other matters not covered in this rules shall be decided by the Organizer (Chess Tournament Committee) who reserves the right to amend or alter any provision of the above-mentioned Rules and Regulations for the success and interest of the tournament.
